Make a Splash – Make a Difference

Local artists, students, teens, children and professionals from all backgrounds are invited to “make a splash” in the local art scene this fall by taking part in *Art Happens*, a city-wide community art project. Buffalonians have the rare opportunity to unite and create a painting unique to Buffalo, for Buffalo, by Buffalo citizens. For a minimum donation fee of \$20, participants are given a tube of paint, to be “splashed” onto a 6 x 16 foot canvas from a 20 foot high balcony.
